

Noun

(plural *rengas* or **renga**)

a form of Japanese verse in which short poems are connected together. Encompasses haikai, the origination point for haiku.

Origin

Japanese *connected verse*, 連歌 .

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NOTE: accidentals apply to the measure, just as in the tradition. In spite of this, a great number of courtesy accidentals were placed throughout the score to facilitate reading. Pedal markings are to be executed accordingly. Pedalization of places without pedal markings is *ad libitum*.
